The Holy Sacrament of Confirmation



Bishop Deenihan will administer the Sacrament of Confirmation on **WEDNESDAY the 6th of May at 11am** in St James' Church Athboy. Any parent who wishes to enrol their child for the sacrament will need to get an application form from the parish office or the sacristies. The forms will be available from the beginning of September.

Also, those who wish to be sponsors must be at least 16 years of age, must have received the sacrament of confirmation and be a practicing catholic. **Forms for application to be a sponsor will also be available in early September and should be returned along with the application for confirmation.**
