Re-scheduled date for Confirmation

To all confirmation candidates, their parents/guardians and sponsors:

Dear Friends,

Bishop Deenihan has made contact with me with good news. He has set a new date for the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation for our Parish.

The government and the HSE have issued clear guidelines about responsible distancing. Therefore it has been decided that the maximum number each candidate can bring with them is three, one of these must be child's sponsor. This situation is not ideal but it is necessary to maximise space and at the same time insure that we are all protected and safe.

There are three schools in our parish so in order to allow each family bring (for example; the candidate, sponsor and two parents) the children will be divided equally into two ceremonies one at 2pm the other at 4pm. I will be meeting the teachers this week to discuss same. It is also looking likely that everyone will have to wear face masks.

Both ceremonies will be private and will take place on Thursday the 23rd of July in St James' Church, Athboy.

The school and the parish will be in contact via email, parish facebook and parish website for more information as the time draws near.
