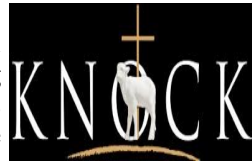

Croagh Patrick - Reek Sunday falls on **Sunday 28 July**, when thousands of pilgrims are expected to scale Croagh Patrick (2,510ft/765m), Ireland's Holy Mountain, to pray and participate on the summit in the Sacraments of Reconciliation (Confession), and of the Eucharist. Pope Francis has designated 2024 as a Year of Prayer, and this year's pilgrimage theme is: 'To pray for and honour grandparents and the elderly'
7:30am until 2pm, Confessions will be heard on the summit.
8am. First hourly Mass on the summit.
2:00pm Last Mass on the summit.
