Fri 16th: St Stephen of Hungary. He was the first King of Hungary and its patron saint. He worked for the conversion of his people to Christianity

Sat 17th: Our Lady of Knock. The story of Knock began on 21st August 1879 when Our Lady, St Joseph, St John the Evangelist, Angels and the Lamb of God appeared at the south gable of Knock Parish Church. Knock is now recognised as an International Eucharistic and Marian Shrine.


