Calendar Feasts this week

Tues 20th August - St Bernard: He was from France and lived from 1090 - 1153. He joined the Cistercian monastery and during his life he became Abbot and established many other monasteries. He worked always for the unity of the Church and against heresies. He is patron saint of Gibraltar and Beekeepers.

Wed 21st August - St Pius X: In 1903 he was elected Pope. During his pontificate he encouraged daily communion and facilitated the communion of children and those who were sick. He also encouraged Bible reading. He died two weeks after the outbreak of World War I in 1914 and was canonised forty years later. The 21st August is also the anniversary of the Apparition in Knock which took place in 1879 when the Blessed Virgin Mary, St Joseph and St John the Evangelist appeared at the South gable of the Parish Church at Knock, Co. Mayo. Beside them and a little to the right was an altar with a cross and the figure of a lamb, around which angels hovered.

Thurs 22nd August - The Queenship of Mary: This memorial celebrates the crowning of Mary as Queen of Heaven which takes place seven days after the Assumption of Mary.

Sat 24th August - St Bartholomew: He is one of the twelve chosen apostles of Jesus
