

Calendar Feasts this week

Mon 5th: Dedication of the Basilica of St Mary Major, Rome - The first church in the western world named in honour of the Mother of God

Tues 6th: The Transfiguration of the Lord - This feast commemorates the day when Jesus, in the company of Peter, James & John was transformed before their eyes on a mountain top. In the Transfiguration God is heard to speak from Heaven which re-enforces who Jesus Christ is for the Apostles who were with him.

Thurs 1st: St Dominic - He was the founder of the order of Preachers who became known as the Dominicans

Fri 9th: St Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein) was a Jew who became Catholic in 1922 and a Carmelite nun. Later she was captured and sent to Auschwitz where she died in its gas chambers
