Liturgical Calendar this week

Monday 9th - St Ciarán of Clonmacnoise: He founded a monastery in Clonmacnoise in January 545 which became one of the most renowned in Europe. He died at the age of 33 while the monastery was still being built.

Tuesday 10th - St Peter Claver: He was a Jesuit missionary who spent thirty-three years in the service of slaves brought against their will to South America during the 17th century.

Thurs 12th - St Ailbe: He is regarded as the patron saint of Munster and at church at Emly, Co. Tipperary. He is the patron saint of the Archdiocese of Cashel and Emly.

Fri 13th - St John Chrysostom: He was well known to be gifted as a speaker. He was made archbishop of Constantinople in 398 and he worked tirelessly for the spread of the faith & its defence against heresies.

Sat 14th - The Exaltation of the Holy Cross: The discovery of the True Cross is dated to 320

The primary Relic of Blessed Carlo Acutis will visit St. Mary's Church, Navan from Sun 15th - Mon 16th Sept. A Parish Novena will begin on Sun 8th in preparation, for the intention that the young people will grow to love Christ in the Eucharist. Carlo Acutis was an Italian website designer who documented Eucharistic miracles and approved Marian apparitions, and catalogued both on a website he

designed before his death from leukaemia. He was noted for his cheerfulness, computer skills, and devotion to the Eucharist, which became a core theme of his life.
