### **Liturgical Calendar this week**

**Tues 1st July-St Oliver Plunkett:** bishop and martyr from Irish nobility whose family supported King Charles 1. Ordained in Rome in 1654, he became a professor of theology and appointed Archbishop of Armagh in 1669. He was the last Catholic to die for his faith at Tyburn, and the first of the Irish martyrs to be beatified in 1920. He was canonised by Pope Paul VI on 12 October 1975. He is buried at Downside Abbey England, his head venerated in St Peter's Church Drogheda.

**Thurs 3rd July-St Thomas,** Apostle is said to have preached the Gospel in India where he was martyred. The faith that led him to know Christ in his wounds also sent him to the farthest places to preach Christ.



# St Oliver Plunkett – 400th Anniversary of his Birth & 50th Anniversary of his Canonisation

This year marks two significant anniversaries in the life of the Church in Ireland and the Diocese of Meath: the 400th anniversary of the birth of St Oliver Plunkett on 1st November 1625, and

the 50th anniversary of his canonisation in 1975. To mark these occasions, Mass will be celebrated by Bishop Tom Deenihan, with the priests of the Diocese of Meath at Loughcrew, the birthplace of St Oliver, on Sunday, 29th June at 3:00 p.m. All are welcome to attend this special celebration in honour of our diocesan saint and martyr. Archbishop of Armagh, Primate of All-Ireland, Most Reverend Eamonn Martin will be the homilist.
