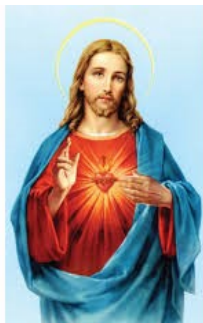


## Hymn for this month - Soul of my Saviour
